Following a recent trial in Dublin the club is proud to announce that two members of our Under 16 side, Eoin Porter and Thomas O'Connor, have been selected to attend the Football Association of Ireland 2013 Under 15 International Training Camp. This camp will take place at AUL Complex from Sunday October 27 to Tuesday October 29, 2013, inclusive under the watchful eye of the recently appointed Under 15 manager, Colin O'Brien. Eoin only signed for the club at the start of this season from near neighbours, Shelburne United and has been an instant hit with our Under 16s. Thomas, meanwhile, is well known to us all, having been with the club since he was a young child. Both players were members of the Wexford Kennedy Bowl winning squad and have both been across the water for trials with Premier League clubs. Meanwhile, Thomas' older brother Donncha was called back for Leinster Youth trials. This is a well deserved recognition for a superbly talented player, currently lining out for the club's Youth and Men's First Team. Donncha was a member of the Wexford Football League Youth team that claimed All Ireland honours last season.
